



## Earn community service hours and become eligible to apply for a scholarship!!!!!!

Each year we give \$25,000 in scholarships to outstanding students in our area who have participated in our Fair in some way over the years. By participating in this program **with a minimum of 10 hours**, your students will be eligible to apply for a scholarship because they will have participated in our Fair. They will also receive community service hours for their service in this program.

**Who can volunteer?** Anyone in high school.

### **Am I guaranteed to be assigned 10 hours if I apply to volunteer?**

**NO!!!!!!** There are a limited amount of shifts available and all shifts are filled on a first come first served basis. **Please DO NOT sign up for shifts that you do not intend to work.** We **DO** expect for you to work a station in our AG-Venture Barn for the entirety of your shifts. It will require for you to interact with the public and invite them to complete different activity within the barn. **We need for our volunteers to be friendly and engaging to the public!!!!!!**

### **Do I have to do the entire ten hours in one year?**

No. It is best if you start accumulating hours **BEFORE** your senior year. We keep track of who volunteers each year and as long as you accumulate ten hours during your high school years, you will be eligible to apply for a scholarship. While we do try to accommodate your requests, we **CANNOT** guarantee that you will be able to complete all 10 hours needed in one Fair year due to the limited amount of hours available during the 11 days of the Fair.

Admission will be paid for those participating. Participating students may come early or stay late to enjoy the Fair before or after their shift. Shifts are set up in 3-5 hour increments. You are welcome to sign up for as many shifts as you would like although we cannot assure that you will be assigned the shifts you request.

**Please note: Weekend shifts are always the first shifts to fill as everyone prefers to work on the weekend. Be sure to include other shifts that you can work if weekends are full. If you ONLY request weekend hours, there is a strong possibility that your request will not be granted.**

**Please see the attached form and return it by October 1<sup>st</sup>.** Shifts will be assigned on a first come first served basis so be sure to return the form **at your earliest convenience** in order to receive the shift you prefer. Confirmation will be sent to you via email.
