## RULES

1. 4-H Club member may submit entries in each clothing level category.
2. The project entry must have been competed within the past 4-H year.
3. Registration will be by number.
4. All similar project displays will be grouped for competitive judging. (EXAMPLE: All Year 2 Clothing projects will be judged against each other.)
5. Judge’s decision will be final.

Up-to-date styling, fashionable, pleasing color, line and texture combination

**2. Appropriateness ..... 25 \_\_\_\_\_**

Pattern and fabrics suitable to purpose of garment.  
Pattern and fabrics, linings, notions, etc., suitable to one another.

**3. Workmanship ..... 50 \_\_\_\_\_**

Hand & machine stitches, matching thread, seams (finished, width), construction pressing and details (buttons, buttonholes, fasteners, zippers, trim), overall construction of garment.
