Permanent - Silk, plastic, paper, etc.

1. Eye Appeal 25 _____

Composition of plants, moss, rocks, container and decorations, Good use of color

2. Suitability & Originality of Container 35 _____

Container MUST be an open, shallow container. (Minus 10 points for inappropriate container. Example: regular flower pot) (There are no restrictions on materials)

3. Mechanics 15 _____

Roots Covered Mechanics of any decorations covered.

4. Plants 25 _____

Plants should have similar cultural requirements. (Water & fertilization needs should be similar) Example: Do not mix cactus and petunias.

Total Points Available 100

1. Eye Appeal 25 _____

Composition & color should be well balanced or blended

2. Suitability of Container 25 _____

No restrictions on size or shape, see through plastic, acrylic, glass, etc. Must be closed with lid top, plastic wrap, etc. Original use of container.

3. Construction 50 _____

Appropriate materials & construction, Drainage materials used (rocks, moss, charcoal), Soil, Plants suitable for terrariums

Optional: Top layer may be decorated with gravel, moss & any items found in nature.

NO ARTIFICIAL ITEMS. Example: ceramics, silk flowers. (Minus 10 points for use of artificial items.)
