*Examples:*

**Dried** - Natural dried flowers, grasses, weeds, wild flowers, bark, small sticks, fruits, vegetables, etc.

**Fresh** - Any natural fresh cut flowers, grasses, weeds, wild flowers, fruits, vegetables, etc.

**Permanent** - Silk, plastic, paper, etc.

## 4-H DISH GARDEN

Total Points Available ..... 100

1. Eye Appeal ..... 25 \_\_\_\_\_

*Composition of plants, moss, rocks, container and decorations, Good use of color*

2. Suitability & Originality of Container ..... 35 \_\_\_\_\_

*Container MUST be an open, shallow container. (Minus 10 points for inappropriate container. Example: regular flower pot) (There are no restrictions on materials)*

3. Mechanics ..... 15 \_\_\_\_\_

*Roots Covered Mechanics of any decorations covered.*

4. Plants ..... 25 \_\_\_\_\_

*Plants should have similar cultural requirements. (Water & fertilization needs should be similar) Example: Do not mix cactus and petunias.*

## 4-H TERRARIUMS

Total Points Available ..... 100

1. Eye Appeal ..... 25 \_\_\_\_\_

*Composition & color should be well balanced or blended*

2. Suitability of Container ..... 25 \_\_\_\_\_

*No restrictions on size or shape, see through plastic, acrylic, glass, etc. Must be closed with lid top, plastic wrap, etc. Original use of container.*

3. Construction ..... 50 \_\_\_\_\_

*Appropriate materials & construction, Drainage materials used (rocks, moss, charcoal), Soil, Plants suitable for terrariums*

**Optional:** Top layer may be decorated with gravel, moss & any items found in nature.

**NO ARTIFICIAL ITEMS.** Example: ceramics, silk flowers. (Minus 10 points for use of artificial items.)

**4-H WREATHS**

*(Wall hung wreaths using floral treatment)*

Total Points Available ..... 100

1. Eye Appeal ..... 30 \_\_\_\_\_

*Unity, Color Blend*

2. Composition ..... 25 \_\_\_\_\_

3. Theme - Carried throughout arrangement ..... 10 \_\_\_\_\_

4. Mechanics ..... 10 \_\_\_\_\_

*Well hidden when necessary, Well secured*

5. Originality ..... 25 \_\_\_\_\_

*Design Form - Metal, straw, wire, wood, styrofoam, grapevine. Combination of elements*

*Examples:*

Any wall hung wreath with natural, dried, permanent/silk flowers, fruits, vegetables.
