4. The Committee reserves the right to reject any exhibit deemed not qualified.
5. A 3”x 5” card must be attached to your exhibit, giving information which would be of interest to the judges and viewing public.
6. Decorations and display will be at the discretion of the Division Chairman and her committee.
7. All exhibits must be properly labeled (not showing) for identification.
8. The Pensacola Interstate Fair, Inc. Sponsoring Committee, employees, members thereof, will not be responsible for the loss or damage to exhibits or any parts thereof. Every precaution will be exercised in the care and handling of exhibits, including guard protection.
9. Competition within the exhibits will be judged for ribbon awards for first, second, third, and

fourth in accordance with the judging scale shown in each division. Honorable Mention ribbons will be given in each of the two divisions.
