To participate in this year's Exhibit please provide the following Information:

If you are unable to scan and email, you may fax the form to the Fair Office at 850-944-4526. This must be received by the deadline that is posted below.

HANGING OF PHOTOS WILL BE SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8 & SUNDAY, OCTOBER 9.

10 am until 4 pm EACH DAY.

There is no fee to enter your pictures in this year's exhibit.

ENTRY RULES

1. Set up times are: Saturday, October 8th and Sunday, October 9th, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Upon arrival, please consult with an exhibit assistant for your assigned space.
2. NOTE: If you have not occupied your assigned space by 3:00 p.m. on Sunday the 9th, it will be reassigned to those that may be on a waiting list.
3. All displayed entries must have your name, address and telephone number on the **back** of each print.
4. All entries must be originals created by the person entering his or her work. By entering your photographs into the Pensacola Interstate Fair Exhibit you affirm that the photographs are your work and your work alone. You have not taken another photographer's photo and re-imaged or edited the photo. Photographers retain all rights to the photographs that belong to them personally. The Pensacola Interstate Fair will remove a photo from the exhibit if it violates the Copyright Law. The photographer of the original photo may seek compensation from the photographer who violated the Copyright Law. Be sure to complete and print the "Photographic Arts Copyright Notice Form" which is available under the "Photographic Arts" section in the Premium Catalog section of the Fair website.
5. All entries must be mounted prior to the time of entry and equipped with wires or hooks for hanging. Metal paper clamps work best on our wire or pegboard panels. Because of moisture and temperature changes in the building, you should not use double sided tape to hold your mats together or tape type hooks on the back of mounted prints as they will not hold.
6. The exhibit is open to all photographers, amateur and professional alike. No names should be visible before judging or the photo will be disqualified.
7. This is a family oriented exhibit. Entries deemed by the chairman to be controversial for family viewing will not be displayed nor judged. We reserve the right to eliminate sensitive subject matter.
8. Photographs entered in previous years will not be accepted.
9. Photographs with titles, numbers or signatures will not be judged.

10. First, Second, Third & Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded for each class. First place winners will compete for Overall Class awards. **ONLY OVERALL CLASS WINNERS RECEIVE CASH AWARDS.**
11. The Chairman reserves the right to reject or reclassify an entries.
12. All reasonable caution in handling & safeguarding of photographs will be exercised. However, the Pensacola Interstate Fair assumes no responsibility for any lost or damaged photographs.
13. All exhibits must remain in place until close of the exhibit. Exhibits must be picked up on Sunday, October 30 between 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Exhibits not retrieved by that time will be left in the exhibit building and the Photographic Arts Exhibit assumes no further responsibility. To retrieve your exhibit after that time, contact the fair office at 850-944-4500.
14. Entries and premiums won by Overall Class winners may be picked up on Sunday, October 30.
15. Photographs that are not picked up will be held at the Fair office.

CLASS 05: FRAMED PHOTOS

All photos in frames. Frames can be any size, however, photographer will be responsible for mounting, hanging and securing the framed photo. Only one framed photo per photographer. All aspects of the photo will be judged, including the frame.

CLASS 06: FAIR PHOTOS

Photos from any of the people, events, animals, food, rides, etc. taken at the Fair.

CLASS RULES & REGULATIONS

1. No names or watermarks should be visible on the photo. Name, address, phone number should be secured to the back of the photograph.
2. Minimum size for all photographs is 8 x 10, however, photos taken by youth may be 5 x 7.
3. Maximum size for all photos is 16 x 20, however, framed photos can be any size.
4. All photos must be in a mat with a border and secured with some type of backing. Photo should not fall out of mat when it has been secured to the display wall.

Only First Place Blue Ribbon winners will compete for cash awards. One First Place Blue Ribbon winner will come from each class.

Rosette ribbons will be given for 2nd and 3rd place winners in each class. Money is only given for blue rosette ribbons in each class.
