REGISTRATION

To participate in this year's Exhibit please provide the following Information:

Name, Address, Phone number, E-mail address, Photo-club affiliation if any, your age if you are under age 18 and space requirement, 1 panel, 1/2 panel or 1/4 panel.

Exhibit panel sizes are approximately 4ft wide X 8ft tall. Please plan your photo display layout in advance of coming to set up your exhibit. Exhibit assistants will not be able to give you more space if your exhibit does not fit into your assigned space. An Exhibitor needing less than one panel should request 1/4 or 1/2 panel.

**You must be registered with the Exhibit Chairman by 5:00 p.m., October 10, 2016 to participate.
There is no fee to enter your pictures in this year's exhibit.**

ENTRY RULES

1. Set up times are: Saturday, October 15th and Sunday, October 16th, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Upon arrival, please consult with an exhibit assistant for your assigned space.
2. NOTE: If you have not occupied your assigned space by 3:00 p.m. on Sunday the 16th, it will be reassigned to those that may be on a waiting list.
3. All displayed entries must have your name, address and telephone number on the **back** of each print.
4. All entries must be originals created by the person entering his or her work.
5. All entries must be mounted prior to the time of entry and equipped with wires or hooks for hanging. Metal paper clamps work best on our wire or pegboard panels. Because of moisture and temperature changes in the building, you should not use double sided tape to hold your mats together or tape type hooks on the back of mounted prints as they will not hold.
6. The exhibit is open to all photographers, amateur and professional alike. No names should be visible before judging or the photo will be disqualified.
7. This is a family oriented exhibit. Entries deemed by the chairman to be controversial for family viewing will not be displayed nor judged. We reserve the right to eliminate sensitive subject matter.
8. Photographs entered in previous years will not be accepted.
9. Photographs with titles, numbers or signatures will not be judged.
10. First, Second, Third & Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded for each class. No money is awarded for winners in each lot. First place winners from each category will compete for Overall Class awards. **ONLY OVERALL CLASS WINNERS RECEIVE CASH AWARDS.**
11. The Chairman reserves the right to reject or reclassify an entries.
12. All reasonable caution in handling & safeguarding of photographs will be exercised. However, the Pensacola Interstate Fair assumes no responsibility for any lost or damaged photographs.

13. All exhibits must remain in place until close of the exhibit. Exhibits must be picked up on Sunday, October 30th between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Exhibits not retrieved by that time will be left in the exhibit building and the Photographic Arts Exhibit assumes no further responsibility. To retrieve your exhibit after that time, contact the fair office at 850-944-4500.
14. Entries and premiums won by Overall Class winners may be picked up on Sunday, October 30.
15. Photographs that are not picked up will be held at the Fair office.

CLASS RULES & REGULATIONS

CLASS 01: Professional – Any person receiving income from photographs.

1. Minimum size 8x10, maximum 16x20
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2” on each side.

CLASS 02: Amateur – Hobby only.

1. Minimum size 5x7, maximum 16x20
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2” on each side.

CLASS 03: Open – Rules are the same as Classes 01 & 02.

1. Minimum size 8x10, maximum 16x20
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2” on each side.
4. Both amateurs and professionals may enter this division.

CLASS 04: Black & White Open – Rules are the same as Classes 01, 02 & 03.

1. Minimum size 8x10, maximum 16x20
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2” on each side.
4. Both amateurs and professionals may enter this division.

CLASS 05: Youth

1. Minimum size 5x7, maximum 16x20
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2” on each side.
4. Age not to exceed 18 years.

CLASS 06: Wide Angle

1. Minimum size 8x10, maximum 16x20
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2” on each side.
4. Both amateurs and professionals may enter this division.

CLASS 07: Framed – Any Size

1. One photo will be selected as Best of Show.
2. Only 1 entry framed.
3. All aspects of photo will be judged, including frame.

PRIZES

Only First Place Blue Ribbon winners will compete for cash awards. One First Place Blue Ribbon winner will come from each LOT in every CLASS. The First Place Blue Ribbon winners will then compete for Overall 1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place & Honorable Mention in each class (these are the only placings with cash awards).
