Students in the two counties who participate in the Fair in any way are eligible to apply for Fair scholarships. Entering the Fair's School Visual Art Exhibit is one of the gateways for high school seniors to become eligible to apply for this valuable college funding source.

## **Art Guidelines**

#### Art Guidelines:

- All art should be the best representation of your program and cover a variety of media and subjects.
- You may use art from the last nine weeks if students are still at your school this current school vear.
- Your art should be mounted/matted or on pedestals/tables that you supply.
- Please use the <u>Official Fair Tag (MAKE A COPY TO EDIT</u>, typed/computer printed, and attached securely to each art piece there should be NO HANDWRITTEN tags.
  - Student Name
  - Grade
  - Title of Work (Secondary, required; Elementary, optional)
  - Media
  - School
  - Art Educator
- Please be careful which glue is used to mount work because it doesn't always hold for the complete length of the fair. Heavier pieces will need more support. No glue sticks or clear tape. The building has a lot of humidity.
- Please include a **SCHOOL SIGN** with the names of the art educators on it. Remember that **each school gets an allocation of space** and all educators at that school must fit within the allotted square foot space assigned.

# Other tips:

- You may use background paper, embellishments, decorations, small tables, etc. to make your exhibit pop and stand out. Be creative and festive!
- You can bring tables, small benches, podiums etch to display student art.
- Artwork should, at a minimum, be matted with one sheet of construction paper and have a printed tag.
- Have a school sign.
- Elementary: double mat with construction paper
- Secondary
- Make sure you use an adhesive that will last for 2 weeks in a humid environment.
